

Creating an ADHD Friendly Home Environment





Course Overview

Is life at home a little chaotic and stressful? Throughout this course, family members will learn about obstacles to creating an ADHD-friendly home environment and strategies to create an ADHD-friendly home environment to help ensure the success of children with ADHD.

CHADD (the National Resource on ADHD) has developed this course to provide educational information and support to individuals and families who are dealing with ADHD and learning to navigate the challenges of ADHD across the lifespan. This self-paced course was modeled after CHADD's exclusive Parent to Parent: Family Training on ADHD program.

Throughout the course, family members will learn how ADHD affects children's self-control, behavior, and communication within the family and strategies to improve the home environment through communication, behavior, and organization strategies. Parents will also have access to the CHADD ADHD online community, customized to promote collaboration, information sharing, and support to parents of children.

Session 0 – Introduction
